June 8, 2020

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Scribner called the virtual meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

2. ACTIVE AGENDA

A. Pavement Management Program.

Transportation Engineer Puymon and Ms. Hammond reviewed the results of the pavement management study, measures necessary to retain and improve current street conditions, and potential funding.

There was extensive discussion on current conditions, funding, and the potential for forming partnerships with other agencies for street preservation measures.

B. Street light LED Conversion of 1,567 Pacific Power owned streetlights in the City.

Public Works Director Bealey reviewed the proposal to convert the streetlights owned by Pacific Power to LED fixtures which will result in energy cost savings to the City.

There was discussion on the proposal, adding security lights in parks, improving street lighting along City streets, and the proposed Interfund loan to pay for the project.
