**2. ACTIVE AGENDA**

A. Interim Zoning Ordinance Wireless Communication Facilities

City Attorney Donaldson provided information on what the City may or may not do regarding regulations on wireless communication facilities.

- Material inhibition test vs. significant gap test
- Unintended consequences, which should be addressed if future permanent regulations are adopted.
- The difference between macro towers and micro (small cell) facilities.

- Shopping availability and what are the considerations.


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- Affordable housing – using Zillow / Realtor.com for comparisons.
